4. SHUTTLECOCKS

We have been trialling different hybrid and feather shuttlecocks due to the high price of Yonex. We have filtered this down to Anyball 333 hybrid (green wrapper) and Yehlex Championship Grade feathers. Unfortunately due to the heat wave in June the hybrid deteriorated and we may try one more batch to test its durability depending on the outcome of item 8.

6. HOLIDAY CLOSURE

7. PLAYING ROTATION & MIXING (SKILL & SEXES)

It has been bought to the Committee's attention that **not all members** are adhering to the Club's Constitution (due for an update and can be downloaded from the website) in line with the rotation and mixing of play. The club will ensure that the rotation and mixing will be fair to all members, and does not support clique groups forming and playing throughout an evening. Please be reminded that this is a Social Club and it was formed to provide a focal point for the promotion and enjoyment of badminton.

Pegboard has been used recently because number of attendance reached 23. Please note that this is used for play rotation so that no player has to sit out for more than 3 games. This may not be an ideal solution but it is a fairer system.

Please also note that games can be played by 1 lady and 3 men since we do not have many lady players resulting to them playing against the same person most of the evening.

8. BADMINTON ENGLAND MEMBERSHIP & INSURANCE

This has been brought up in the last newsletter and we shall remind you again.

Members were consulted on the Minutes of the AGM whether they use the benefit given by Badminton England but only a handful of people replied and the answer was 'NO'. This is a very costly membership and we are looking into not renewing when it becomes due at the end of October this year providing members are happy to leave Badminton England. Please note that this will mean anyone who plays outside of The Club will not have Public Liability Insurance. The Club will source Public Liability Insurance independently and once again please note that this does not cover Personal Injuries. Members will be informed nearer the time.

Without this cost, we can play feather shuttlecocks at all times.
